Combining two CD's \$5596.80 and \$11,104.58 for one year

Three from the Water Fund Reserve and Three from the Sewer Fund Reserve as follows

\$66,000 for 6 months, \$66,000 for one year and 68,000 for 18 months for each reserve account.

The CD's will be rolled over every 6 months
