Citizens Comments: Proposal from Mark Scott for trees, planters and lamp poles for Main Street.

Old Business:

National Grid sent an application to be filled out for the use of their poles to put Christmas lights on. This will be taken care of this week.

Tree lighting ceremony tentatively set for Saturday November 25th at the Pavilion.

Trustee Mayette said the Fire Department would help with putting lights on the Christmas tree in the Pavilion.

They also said they may be able to buy some Christmas Lights for the tree.

New Business:

Six new doors are being installed in the Arena

A Grant is being completed for the Civic Center to help cover costs.

Mayor Otto-Cassada will be attending a meeting with NYPA about Energy Efficient Monies that will be distributed to qualifying municipalities.

Heating, cooling and lights for the Arena

Reimbursement to Fire Department for the roof and insulation

Chris will look into the dimension of Solar Panels for the Village of Waddington in preparation for Mayor Otto-Cassada's meeting with NYPA

Senator Patty Ritchie has secured \$50,000 for the Waddington Fire Department. This money will be to put in new bathrooms, including a handicapped bathroom and shower.

All the paperwork is in for the money and they are just waiting for the money to come in to complete the project.

Trustee Mayette asked about the dry hydrant at the end of Main Street

One of the locations that would work is behind the lab building, but the crane pad would work

A letter from the county was received about the right away at the Franklin Road Bridge while the bridge is under construction

The letter did not mention that this would be a temporary right of way until the completion of the project.

This will have to be added to the agreement
