Call to Order: Mayor Janet Otto-Cassada called the regular meeting to order at 6:00pm

Citizen Comments:

Tammy Simons brought up the cost of the liability insurance that is required to rent the Island View park Pavilion. She was under the impression that there have been some people that have not had to pay this. A discussion ensued and the matter will be looked into. The total amount of liability will also be looked into.

Roger Bailey and Rita Goldberg from the SLC Historical Society are interested in borrowing items from the Moore Museum. These items would include things to do with James Ricalton. They are doing research on him and will have an exhibit containing these items. James Ricalton was born in Waddington in 1844 and was a world-famous photographer.

DPW:

Chris was approached by Bill Tiernan and Mike McIntosh about fixing the sidewalk in front of the Legion on Fenton Street. They would like the Village to supply the material and Bill would supply the labor.

Discussion ensued

A motion was made by Trustee Thew and 2nd by Trustee Zagrobelny to approve the sidewalk project on Fenton Street in front of the Legion as long as the specs are in compliance

Chris was approached by Bill Tiernan about paving the side of the new IGA on the Franklin Road side where the parking is done. Bill said if the Village would provide the material, he would supply the labor

The paving will start at James Street to the end of St. Lawrence Crescent

The Village will take care of manholes and trucking
