Citizens Comment:

Patty VanPatten thanked the DPW for taking the plants down from the Village streets
Patty asked about the Bass Master Elite group losing some of their top fisherman to the MLF (Major League fishing) and how that will affect the upcoming tournaments and could it result in a Null contract with the Village of Waddington.

Mayor Cassada explained that the Village is not responsible for the Bass Contract. The North Country Events Committee is responsible and is partnering with the St. Lawrence County Chamber. Discussion ensued.

DPW:

Security cameras have been installed at the Pavilion.
The playground is being installed this week
NTC is putting in new sidewalks at Island View Park
All docks are out except the ramp dock, which will be out soon
Franklin Road Bridge will be open November 10, 2018
Water Pump panel will be installed next Wednesday or Thursday
The Village will be looking to NYPA to install new docks at the end of main Street due to disrepair
Chris would like to change the dock rental agreement to read October 1st that all boats are to be out, so as to have the docks pulled earlier due to inclement weather
The furnace has been installed in the Moore Museum, the heat is on 55, and the windows are sealed up for the winter
The snow plow has been installed on the new Village pickup
Mayor Otto-Cassada thanked the DPW for moving the playground equipment before Halloween and the install of the equipment

Old Business:

Thank you to Kim Robertson for the proper disposal of old American flags

Another act of vandalism was had at the Pavilion, the young man was apprehended and will be paying restitution through family court

Trustee Miller reported on the Fireman's Cancer Fund

The Village of Waddington has 25 interior firemen, each fireman will have to have a physical to determine they are cancer free before they are eligible for this program

The program is setup to cover the fireman if they get cancer as the cause of their duties as a firefighter

Trustee Fairchild has been in contact with Sunshine, a representative regarding a grant for continued work on the Civic Center. Sunshine sent documents that will be reviewed and submitted for the grant
